YOUR RIGHT: Act. 42 U. S. C. § 1983 – Be it enacted...That any person, under color of any law, statue, ordinance, regulation, custom, or usage of any State shall subject, or cause to be subjected any person within the jurisdiction of the United States to the deprivation of any rights, privileges, or immensities secured by the Constitution of the United States, shall, any such law, statute, ordinance, custom or usage of the State to the contrary notwithstanding, be liable to the party injured in any action at law suit in equity, or other proper proceeding for redress...

Sec. 2. That if two or more persons within any State or Territory of the United States shall conspire together to overthrow, or to put down, or to destroy by force the government of the United States...or by force, intimidation, or treat to prevent any person from accepting or holding any office or trust or place of confidence under the United States, or from discharging the duties thereof...or to injure him in his person or property on account of his lawful discharge of the duties of his office, or to injure his person while engaged in the lawful discharge of his office...or by force, intimidation, or threat to deter any part of witness in any court of the United States from attending court...or shall conspire together from the purpose in any manner impeding, hindering, obstructing or defeating the due course of justice in any State or Territory, with intent to deny to any citizen of the United States the due and equal protection of the laws...or threat to prevent any citizen of the United States lawfully entitled to vote from giving his support or advocacy in a lawful manner towards or in favor of the election of any lawfully qualified person as any elector of the President or Vice-President of the Unite States, or as a member of the Congress of the United States, or to injure any such citizen in his person or property on account or such support or advocacy, each and every person so offending shall be deemed guilty of a high crime...
